Whereas, there are numerous highway improvements needed in Central Texas for regional traffic, flow and;

Whereas, these improvements have been planned and funded for many years, and;

Whereas, portions of the current plans for toll roads as proposed by TxDOT appear arbitrary, and;

Whereas, these plans do not fully address mobility issues, and;

Whereas, there has been a lack of public involvement in the decision to develop a system of toll roads,

Now, therefore the Oak Hill Association of Neighborhoods (OHAN) opposes the imposition of toll roads on existing routes, and

Further, OHAN asks CAMPO to request a review by TxDOT of statewide transportation policy decisions regarding toll roads.
