# Guest Speakers No. 2: TXDOT / CTRMA Wade Strong, Lynda Rife, Jimmy Roberts

The representatives from TXDOT / CTRMA presented the update on the Oak Hill Expressway and the South Mopac project.. They encouraged people to contact them by email, in writing, or on the phone, or to go to one of the WorkShops that they have arranged. The South MoPac project is to build 8.2 miles of HOV lanes and a couple of over passes or under passes at Slaughter and LaCrosse.

The map had been drawn by a retired GIS map guy who had worked for the State of Texas, so he seemed to know what he was doing. The membership voted by unanimous consent to go forward with the proposal to the ICRC.

- Nominating Committee is looking for a few people to possibly run for the OHAN Board.
